

Tips for measuring **Round** post pads:

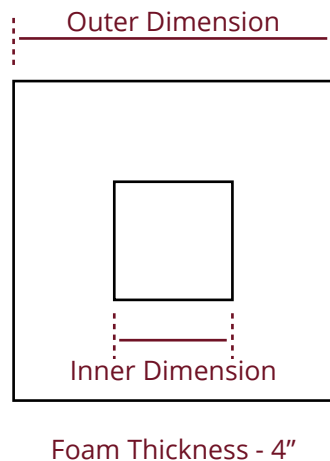
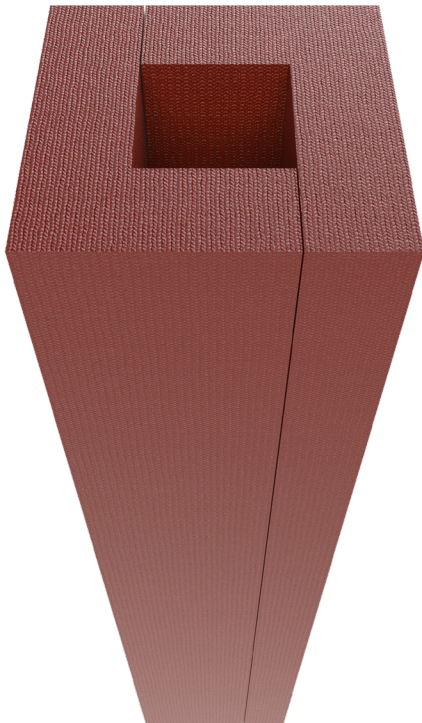
1 - Starting with your existing post, take a small piece of string and wrap it around the post. Make a small mark on the string where it meets the starting point.

2 - Remove the string from the post, and lay it on a flat, smooth surface. Using a standard tape measure, measure the length from the starting point to your mark.

3 - Using that measurement, divide that number by 3.14 (Pi). *This measurement is your Post Pad Inner Diameter.*

4 - The outer diameter is calculated by taking the inner diameter measurement and adding 8" overall.

5 - Determine the height needed for padding. Standard height is 72" (6 feet).



Tips for measuring **Square** or **Rectangular** post pads:

1 - Starting with your existing post, measure each side of the post. There should be (4) measurements total.

2 - For standard square posts, the distance of each measurement should be the same. For posts that are rectangle in shape, the measurements will differ.

3 - The outer dimension is calculated by taking the inner measurement and adding 8" overall.

4 - Determine the height needed for padding. Standard height is 72" (6 feet).

Post Pads are available for installation around posts providing an extra measure of safety for active players. The pads are constructed utilizing 18 ounce coated vinyl, which covers a 4" thick, high density, urethane foam.

Pads feature hook and loop fasteners and are available in 11 standard colors. Please specify your color choice when ordering. All pads are 6-feet high and cover post applications from 3-1/2" O.D. to 6-5/8" O.D. Custom size pads, as well as, lettering, colors, and logo design available, contact us for price quote.
